Travelling to Melbourne Private Hospital





Melbourne Private Hospital (MPH) is co-located with a number of health services and research institutes on the Parkville precinct in the inner city of Melbourne. We strongly recommended that patients and visitors consider using public transport, taxis or ride share services wherever possible. There is very limited car parking available on-site or in the surrounding streets.

You will require a 'myki' to travel on trains, trams and buses in Melbourne. You can find the nearest place to buy a myki or buy a myki online at www.ptv.vic.gov.au/tickets/myki/

Trams - Nos. 19, 58 and 59

- The No. 19 (North Coburg route info <u>here</u>) tram travels along Elizabeth Street from Flinders Street Station in the CBD it stops directly outside MPH in Royal Parade at Tram stop 10 located at the corner of Royal Parade and Grattan Street.
- The No. 58 (West Coburg route info <u>here</u>) tram travels along William Street in the CBD and then up Flemington Road – it is recommended that you alight at Tram Stop No. 14 opposite the Royal Women's Hospital.
- The No. 59 (Airport West route info <u>here</u>) tram travels along Elizabeth Street from Flinders Street Station and up Flemington Road – it is recommended that you alight at Tram Stop No. 14 opposite the Royal Women's Hospital, which joins the Royal Melbourne Hospital.

Train

- You may travel to Melbourne Central station then catch a connecting No. 19 or No. 59 tram. You may also travel to North Melbourne station then catch a connecting No. 401 bus.
- Alternatively, you may travel to Flagstaff station then catch the connecting No. 58 tram as described above.
- Please note, opening hours are limited on the weekend at Flagstaff station. Parkville station adjacent to Melbourne Private Hospital is scheduled to open in 2025 forming the Sunbury to Cranbourne/Pakenham line.

Bus - Nos. 401 and 402

Nos. 401 (North Melbourne – University of Melbourne service - route info <u>here</u>) and 402 (Footscray – East Melbourne service - route info <u>here</u>) Due to road closures on Grattan Street bus stop locations have temporarily changed. The inbound bus stop is located on Wreckyn Street and the outbound bus stop is located on Flemington Road. All stops are in close proximity to Melbourne Private Hospital.

Taxi Services

- Our friendly reception staff may book taxis for patients and visitors if extra assistance is required.
- Please note, during the Metro Tunnel works the closest taxi rank is located on Flemington Road.

Car

Please allow extra time to find parking. You may use the:

 Paid Underground car park behind Melbourne Private Hospital is commercially managed by an external provider.

The carpark is open everyday, 6am - 9pm. An intercom button is available 24 hours a day at the entrance and exits to the car park.

First 30 minutes free on Monday - Friday before 5pm.

A flat rate of \$12 applies after 5pm on weekdays and on weekends.

If you are a regular visitor, a reduced parking rate is available. Please liaise directly with the parking office to discuss your eligibility.

Disabled Access

- Is available on street level (also known as Level 1)
 via pedestrian ramps at both the front entrance and rear entrance of Melbourne Private Hospital
- Paid disabled parking is available in the underground car park behind Melbourne Private Hospital.
